7. Two (2) working days notice shall be given to the Jackson County Engineer's Office before commencing the above work in order to inform the public.
8. All work performed by the applicant shall be under the inspection and approval of the Jackson County Engineer.
9. All roadside facilities (culverts, guardrail, signs, etc.) and areas disturbed by the applicant's work shall be returned to their original conditions, including seeding & mulching.
10. The applicant shall provide all labor, equipment and materials necessary to complete the permit work.
11. If applicant is excavating, he/she is responsible for calling "OUPS" at 1-800-362-2764 as well as all non-OUPS utilities at least 2 days prior to start of work, for the safe location of existing utilities in county road right-of-way.
12. The applicant shall maintain traffic at all times. All work requiring individuals or vehicles on the pavement or shoulders shall comply with all the requirements of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and Item 614 (Maintaining Traffic) of the Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications. Failure to comply with this requirement will be cause for immediate suspension of the permit until proper traffic controls (flaggers & warning signs) have been provided.
13. The applicant assumes liability for all actions associated with the work done by the applicant and will save the County harmless from any and all claims for personal injury and property damages arising out of work done.
14. The applicant may be required by the Jackson County Engineer to secure a performance bond or certified check in an amount sufficient to insure the completion and restoration of the work performed by the applicant in the road right-of-way. A PLAN OR DRAWING MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THIS APPLICATION.
